



“Day Before Inspection” Check List

Here's a list of items that we need your help on (if you have any questions, please call us) the day before so the inspection can run smoothly:

1. ___ Hookup the 30 or 50 amp power cord (test appliances/air conditioners)
2. ___ Park the RV on a stable, dry, flat parking surface.
3. ___ Connect a freshwater hose and turn the water on. Make sure the fresh water tank at least 1/4 full.
4. ___ Connect a sewer hose to the septic tank.
5. ___ Make sure that the propane tank is at least 1/4 full.
6. ___ If the RV is winterized, it must be *fully* de-winterized prior to inspection start time.
7. ___ Turn on the refrigerator at least **12 hours before the inspection begins.**
8. ___ Check all of the remote controls for proper operation. Replace batteries as needed.
9. ___ Place all RV manuals and manufacturer "build sheet" documents on the dining table or counter.
10. ___ Place all keys for the RV on the dining table or counter.
11. ___ Unlock all storage bays before the inspection.

I will also send you

- a *Pre-Inspection Agreement* for you to sign and
- an *invoice* to pay for the inspection.
